Nicola Upson was born in Suffolk and read English at Downing College, Cambridge. She has worked in theatre and as a freelance journalist, and is the author of two non-fiction works and the recipient of an Escalator Award from the Arts Council England. Her debut novel, *An Expert in Murder*, was the first in a series of crime novels to feature Josephine Tey – one of the leading authors of Britain's age of crime-writing. The book was dramatised by BBC Scotland for Radio 4's *Woman's Hour*, and praised by P.D. James as marking 'the arrival of a new and assured talent'.

Nicola was shortlisted for the CWA Historical Dagger in 2018 for *Nine Lessons*, and her latest novel, *Shot With Crimson* is the eleventh book in the series. She lives with her partner in Cambridge and Cornwall, and is also the author of *Stanley and Elsie*, a standalone novel about the painter Stanley Spencer.
