**Confirmation of Payee**

When making the payment on line you may receive a message to say that the account name does not match the account number. The reason for this is Confirmation of Payee (CoP) which is a new name-checking service warning bank customers when a payee's name doesn't match the account number provided.

Under the direction of the payments regulator, the six largest banking groups: Barclays, Lloyds Banking Group, Royal Bank of Scotland Group, Santander, HSBC Group (excluding M&S Bank) and Nationwide Building Society must all offer Confirmation of Payee (or 'CoP') to protect customers when they pay someone new or edit an existing payee.

However the Co-op Bank has not yet introduced CoP and as a result you **may** receive a message to say that the account cannot be checked by your own bank.

This does not mean you cannot proceed with the payment, all it is flagging up to you is that the account name cannot be checked at the present time until the Co-Op introduce CoP.
