Mosaic knitting is colour work technique that is suitable for any level knitter. Unlike fair isle, it creates patterns without the need to carry yarn along the row. One colour at a time is used to knit in stripes, and the



contrasting colour stitches as slipped. As an introduction to mosaic knitting we will make this 10cm square. Once you have mastered a square you are on your way to a snood or a scarf!

#### **TicketSource**

Some FAQs about TicketSource:

#### What is TicketSource?

TicketSource is a UK based online booking system. All new CFWI events will be booked using TicketSource including taking payments on our behalf.

#### Will I pay a booking fee?

TicketSource charges a 6.5% (plus VAT) booking fee for each ticket. This will be included in the overall cost of an event rather than as an additional payment.

#### How do I book with TicketSource?

You will have 3 options:

Use our dedicated page on **TicketSource** <u>https://</u> <u>www.ticketsource.co.uk/cambridge-federation-wi</u> and select the event you wish to book. You will need to fill in your contact and payment details as well as any event preferences such as menu choices. At the end of the booking you will receive an email confirming your place on the event.

**By Telephone**: Use the **TicketSource Telephone Box Office Service** (call 0333 666 3366). You can pay over the phone and give your contact details and preferences relating to the event.

**By Post:** Send cash or cheque payment to the CFWI Office with written contact details and preferences relating to the event. We will make the booking on your behalf.

### Can I still buy tickets for friends and other WI members?

You will still be able to make bulk bookings for several members in your WI at the same time, please ensure you have the contact details (email and phone number) and event preferences for each person.

#### What happens if I need to cancel my booking?

If you decide to cancel your booking before the closing date – TicketSource will keep the booking fee portion of the cost and refund the remainder directly into your account. (eg If you paid £10 you will be refunded  $\pm 9.22$ ).

#### What happens If CFWI cancels an event?

TicketSource will refund the **full amount** directly into your account.

#### What happens if an event is fully booked?

The number of places available for each event will be clear when you go onto TicketSource. If the event is fully booked you will be able to join a waiting list so CFWI can plan whether or not it can offer another date, or try to book a bigger coach etc.
